Proseco is the security company from Heineken, that is responsible for the security of the Holland Heineken House during the Olympic Games. This is the location where the Dutch athletes, supporters and trade and industry meet.

René Polfliet from Proseco about REASeuro:

"I met John Blokvoort from REASeuro at a lecture on security. Both of us being ex military men we immediately had chemistry, which lead to REASeuro executing a zero check with an explosive dog detection team before the official opening of the Olympic Games in Athens. Furthermore, REASeuro provided a course for bomb detection specialized on improvised explosive devices for the staff of Proseco.



During the whole period of the Olympic Games in Turin the REASeuro explosive dog detection team was deployed. REASeuro staff is not only very knowledgeable in the area of explosives, but also in the area of safety and security. They are flexible and help finding solutions. This was a prerequisite, since in Turin circumstances were changing all the time. E.g. a number of new entrances in the Holland Heineken House were made available at the last moment. REASeuro reacted very professionally and alert on changes and took immediate appropriate actions.

I've not often experienced people anticipating on our needs so well. They assisted our staff whenever it was busy. They were at the entrance, addressed people on their behaviour and observed the situation together with our own staff.

At most other companies a dog team consists of 1 employee with 1 dog. However, at REASeuro the team consists of an employee that focuses on the dog and another employee that concentrates on the possible presence of explosives. This makes a much more reliable impression."
